  - Exceed regulated driving hours,
  - Not take their required minimum rest breaks,
  - Nor do we condone any Driver to leave our premises while impaired by fatigue or other form of health that will compromise the safety of themselves, our employees, our customers and those sharing the road.
- We expect that all Heavy Vehicles and their loads comply with relevant mass and dimension requirements, and that those requirements are verified with each Driver before being loaded.
- We will not and do not condone any person(s) within our Chain of Responsibility cycle to negatively influence our professional conduct.
- We will continue to review and improve our health, safety and quality management systems to ensure the applicability and effectiveness of our CoR Policy and processes.
